

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Call Public Hearings To Satisfy The Public Participation Requirement For Ulster County's 2007 Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) And As Needed To Seek Comments On Past CDBG Program Performance

The Economic Development, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee (Chairman Rodriguez and Legislators Berardi, Gregorius, Loughran, Sheeley, Alfonso and Roberti) offers the following:

WHEREAS, participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) administered by the Governor's Office of Small Cities (GOSC) requires the holding of two Public Hearings consistent with a Community's Public Participation Plan, prior to the submittal of a grant application as well as an Annual Hearing to discuss past program performance, and

WHEREAS, the County desires to hold the necessary hearings to seek comments on the direction of its CDBG Program, Past Program Performance, and any application that may be developed, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to call Public Hearings as necessary to satisfy the public participation requirements of the CDBG Program in accordance with Ulster County's CDBG Public Participation Plan.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature is directed to cause any notice of hearings in relationship to the CDBG Program to be posted on County Buildings' bulletin boards, and

FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature is directed to provide copies of any CDBG Hearing notice to all chief elected officials of municipalities within Ulster County,

and moves its adoption.
