WHEREAS, these funds are proceeds from URGENT cases only and do not include any County dollars, and

WHEREAS, these funds can only be used for the benefit of investigating drug and gang criminal cases, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has been met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
