

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into A Memorandum Of Understanding With The New York State Office Of Children And Family Services For Day Care Registration And Inspection Program Funding – Department Of Social Services**

The Health and Human Services Committee (Chairman Frey and Legislators Harris, Maio, Petit, Ronk, Briggs, Loughran, Robert Parete and Stoeckeler) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Social Services, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the New York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS), to receive funding in the amount of \$139,787.00 for the Day Care Registration and Inspection Program, for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, this program provides funding for processing (1) initial day-care facility registration applications; (2) renewals of existing registrations; (3) complaint investigations; and (4) safety assessments, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval; and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State OCFS to receive funding in the amount of \$139,787.00 for the Day Care Registration and Inspection Program, for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
