

Resolution No. 283 November 13, 2012

Amending The 2012 Ulster County Budget – Transferring Contingency Funds To Pay Jail Medical Bills - Ulster County Sheriff's Office

The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairman Richard Parete and Legislators Belfiglio, Maio, Ronk and Briggs) and the Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Provenzano and Rodriguez)

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Richard Parete, and Deputy Chairman Kenneth Ronk offer the following:

WHEREAS, the County has contracted with Correctional Medical Care, Inc. to provide medical services to inmates housed at the Ulster County Jail; and

WHEREAS, the contract provides that the County is responsible for all inmate medical bills over the contracted \$10,000 catastrophic amount per inmate; and

WHEREAS, there are several medical service charges from 2010 - 2012 that were never billed and therefore never paid; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of these invoices is \$112,226.00 and there are insufficient funds in the Sheriff's medical services budget to cover this cost; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requests that funds from the contingency account be transferred and the 2012 Ulster County Budget be amended accordingly; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the 2012 Ulster County Budget is hereby amended as follows:
