

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With New York State Division Of Criminal Justice Services – District Attorney’s Recruitment And Retention Program – Ulster County District Attorney

The Criminal Justice and Safety Committee (Chairman Dart and Legislators Briggs, Richard Parete, Zimet, Hansut, Maloney, and Ronk) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County District Attorney, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County District Attorney has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement, being said contract (T088636) in the amount of \$24,218.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the District Attorney’s Recruitment and Retention Program for the purpose of improving the recruitment and retention of qualified and experienced prosecutors through salary enhancement, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney’s Recruitment and Retention Program, Project No. LG08-1381-D00 is Federal Pass-Thru State funded and will be administered for the period, starting January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any future amendments thereto and, being said contract (T088636) in the amount of \$24,218.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the District Attorney’s Recruitment and Retention Program for the period of January 1, 2009 through December, 2009, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and, be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be reconsidered for future funding,
