WHEREAS, the District Attorney requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement (C108371), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for a Crimes Against Revenue Program (CARP) grant in the amount of \$99,500.00, for the period commencing January 1, 2011 and ending September 30, 2011, and

WHEREAS, the funds from this grant will be exclusively used to hire a designated Assistant District Attorney to specialize in the investigation and prosecution of revenue crimes against New York State committed within Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and approved said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement (C108371), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for a CARP grant in the amount of \$99,500.00, for the period commencing January 1, 2011 and ending September 30, 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
