WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Planning; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Homes and Community Renewal Office of Community Renewal has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the following programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Main Streets, RESTORE, Affordable Homeownership Development Program (AHDP), Access to Home, and HOME, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County is intending to make an application under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) that requires a public hearing consistent with Federal Requirements found in 24 CFR 570.486 prior to the submittal of the grant application; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to hold the necessary hearing to seek comments on the direction of its CDBG Program, and any application for funding that may be developed; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to call public hearings as necessary to satisfy the public participation requirements of the CDBG Program in accordance with 24 CFR 570.486; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, December 10, 2013 at 7:00 PM in Legislative Chambers, Ulster County Office Building, 244 Fair Street, 6th Floor, Kingston, New York; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature shall cause any notice of hearings to be posted on County Buildings' bulletin boards, and published in official publications; and, be it further

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RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature shall provide copies of the hearing notice to all chief elected officials of municipalities within Ulster County;
