

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Contract With The New York State Department Of Health To Participate In The Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program – Department Of Health**

The Health and Human Services Committee (Chairman Frey and Legislators Harris, Petit, Ronk, Briggs, Robert Parete, and Stoeckeler) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Health, and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Director requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-026844), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health to participate in the Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program, for the period October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015, with funding presently approved in the amount of \$267,973.00 for the initial year, and

WHEREAS, funding will be used to support and enhance local efforts to target multi-family, non-owner-occupied, pre-1978 dwellings in the City of Kingston where children ages six and under reside, and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the program's objectives, community partnerships will be developed, and these partners will provide public outreach and education and assist in identifying residents who may qualify for risk assessments for lead, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-026844), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health to participate in the Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program, for the period October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015, and accept first year funding in the amount of \$267,973.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
