

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The Town Of Ulster For Use Of The Ulster Police Firearms Range And Training Facility – Ulster County Sheriff's Office**

The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairman Hayes and Legislators Belfiglio, Ronk, Sweeney, Briggs, Hochberg and Rodriguez) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Sheriff, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff is requesting that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Town of Ulster for the use of the Ulster Police Firearms Range and Training Facility, located on Ulster Landing Road in the Town of Ulster, and

WHEREAS the Sheriff's Office is required by law to provide firearms training and practice for its sworn officers and seeks to use this facility for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, such use shall be made available at no cost to the County, and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Town of Ulster, for the contract period from January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
