**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To
Execute Certain Inter- Municipal Agreements For Domestic
Violence Investigators – Department Of Social Services**

Chairman of the Social Services Committee, Mary Wawro, and Deputy Chairman Hector S. Rodriguez offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Social Services currently has Inter-Municipal Agreements with the Town of Ulster and New York State Division of State Police, for the provision of domestic violence investigators; and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administrative Code provide that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, can enter into an Inter-Municipal Agreement of behalf of the County of Ulster; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized, pursuant to this resolution, to execute two Inter-Municipal Agreements for domestic violence investigators for the term January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, with the Town of Ulster and New York State Police in the amounts as indicated below:

Town of Ulster Investigator	\$100,972.00
NYS Police Senior Investigator	\$202,578.00

and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute Inter-Municipal Agreements, and any amendments thereto, with the Town of Ulster in the amount of \$100, 972.00 and the New York State Division of State Police in the amount of \$202,578.00, to provide Ulster County with the services of domestic violence investigators for the term January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further
