Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature And The Ulster County Sheriff To Sign An Agreement With The BOCES School District For A School Resource Officer (SRO) For The Period Commencing On July 1, 2006 Through June 30, 2007 – Sheriff's

The Criminal Justice and Safety Committee (Chairman Dart and Legislators Distel, Gregorius, R.A. Parete, Zimet, Aiello and Every) offers the following:

WHEREAS, Ulster County BOCES has requested a Deputy Sheriff to be assigned as a School Resource Officer (SRO) at the BOCES School District, and

WHEREAS, BOCES will reimburse Ulster County 100% for providing a School Resource Officer at the sum of \$80,000.00 (payable in equal quarterly payments) for the 2006-2007 school year, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature and the Ulster County Sheriff be authorized to sign an agreement with the BOCES School District for a School Resource Officer (SRO) for the period commencing on July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign an agreement with Ulster County BOCES to provide a School Resource Officer, commencing on July 1, 2006 and continuing through June 30, 2007, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
