

Authorizing The Chairman of The Ulster County Legislature To Apply For And Accept Section 5311 Federal And State Funding Under the Terms Of An Existing Continuing Agreement With The New York State Department Of Transportation For The Purchase of Two Diesel Buses For Fiscal Year 2014 – Department Of Public Transportation (Ulster County Area Transit)

Referred to: The Economic Development and Tourism Committee (Chairman Maloney and Legislators Maio, Roberts, Loughran and Wishnick) and The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Provenzano and Rodriguez)

Chairman of the Economic Development and Tourism Committee, James F. Maloney, and Deputy Chairman Peter M. Loughran offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Public Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County is a designated recipient of Section 5307 and Section 5311 funds from New York State and the Federal Transit Administration; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County Area Transit (UCAT) is submitting a grant application to the New York State Department of Transportation, pursuant to Section 5311, Title 49 United States Code, for the purchase of two (2) low floor diesel cutaway buses to replace vehicles that have reached their useful life; and

WHEREAS, such buses will be used by UCAT to provide public mass transportation service for the County of Ulster; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County and the State of New York have entered into a continuing agreement which authorizes the undertaking of bus purchases and the guarantee of payment by the State for its proportionate share for such buses used in rural areas of Ulster County; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of these capital purchases is \$450,000 with funding sources of 80% Federal (\$360,000), 10% State (\$45,000), and 10% Local (\$45,000); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Transportation to apply for and accept funding consisting of New York State and Federal funds for the purchase of two diesel cutaway buses in the amount of \$450,000.00 for fiscal year 2014, in the form as filed with the Clerk of

and moves its adoption.
