WHEREAS, the Director of Ulster County Alternative Sentencing has requested a replacement van to continue community services, and

WHEREAS, the 15 passenger Dodge Van which is used by the Ulster County Alternative Sentencing Department to transport community service work crews to various Towns and the City of Kingston has been declared a safety hazard by the Ulster County Safety Office, and

WHEREAS, the vehicle is being pulled from service for safety and liability reasons, and

WHEREAS, the removal of this vehicle has caused an emergency situation, and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a new vehicle is necessary to meet the transportation demands, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice/Public Safety/STOP DWI Committee has been polled with a majority of the members voicing approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
