WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Planning, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County is in receipt of a Housing Rehabilitation Grant from the NYS Office of Community Renewal funded through the Community Development Block Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 289 dated October 14, 2009, authorized the County Executive to enter into the necessary contracts and provide the required certifications to effectuate the grant, and

WHEREAS, Program Rules require the completion of an Environmental Review Record (ERR) and findings regarding the program's impact in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature has reviewed the ERR on file with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature has also reviewed the program's compliance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA - 6 NYCRR Part 617).

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature determines that implementation of the Housing Rehabilitation Program will have no significant effect on the environment pursuant to NEPA and accordingly a finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is made, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature determines that the Housing Rehabilitation Program is a Type II Action under 6NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(1) and no additional environmental review is necessary,
