

Resolution No. 346 November 10, 2004

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Amendment To The Agreement With New York State Aid To Prosecution Program (APP) – Ulster County District Attorney’s Office

The Criminal Justice / Public Safety / STOP DWI Committee (Chairman Meyer and Legislators Aiello, DePew, Every, Dart, Feldmann and Hyatt) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster and the State of New York have previously entered into an agreement for the Aid to Prosecution Program (APP), the term of which expired March 31, 2004, and

WHEREAS, the State of New York has now appropriated funds to continue such program for an additional year, for the period April 1, 2004 through March 31, 2005, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice/Public Safety/STOP DWI Committee has met and approved said request with a majority of members voting approval.

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and approved said request with a majority of members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services, in the form as on file with the Clerk of the Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, for the purpose of Ulster County’s participation in the Aid to Prosecution Program, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, county participation will be reviewed by the Ways and Means Committee,

and moves its adoption.
