

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature And The Acting Commissioner Or Commissioner Of Social Services To Enter Into Agreements With The NYS Office Of Children And Family Services – 2007 Resource Allocation Plan – Youth Bureau – Social Services

WHEREAS, the Acting Commissioner of Social Services has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into agreements with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services for the Ulster County Youth Bureau's 2007 Resource Allocation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Acting Commissioner of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into agreements as necessary, in order for the Ulster County Youth Bureau to fulfill its obligations to execute the 2007 Resource Allocation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Youth Bureau has met, reviewed all submitted proposals as well as program monitoring documents and the majority of members have voted approval of the proposed 2007 Resource Allocation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into agreements with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services and the Acting Commissioner or Commissioner of Social Services be authorized to enter into agreements as necessary, in order for the Ulster County Youth Bureau to fulfill its obligations to execute the 2007 Resource Allocation Plan, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
