

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Inter-Municipal Agreement With The Kingston City School District For Prevention Services – Department Of Mental Health

The Health and Human Services Committee (Chairman Frey and Legislators Fabiano, Harris, Petit, Briggs, Robert Parete and Stoeckeler) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Mental Health, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Mental Health has inter-municipal agreements pertaining to various substance abuse prevention programs within the schools, and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G, and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administrative Code provide that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, can enter into an Inter-Municipal Agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to General Municipal Law, Section 119-n(a) the definition of a municipality includes a school district, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Mental Health is requesting that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an Inter-Municipal Agreement and any amendments to the agreement with the Kingston City School District for the continued operation of substance abuse prevention services funded through the NYS Office of Alcoholism & Substance Abuse Services (OASAS), for the period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an Inter-Municipal Agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Kingston City School District for the continued operation of NYS OASAS-funded prevention programs, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified and approved by the County Attorney,
