WHEREAS, Ulster County's Stormwater Management Program Annual Report indicates that additional resources are necessary in order to achieve compliance in a timely manner, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Water Quality Management Agency working with municipal partners has prepared a work program that will ensure compliance relative to the six minimum control measures, and

WHEREAS, New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) has made available funding in Round 9 of the Water Quality Improvement Projects that provides for State Assistance Payments in implementing Stormwater Phase II General Permit requirements that can be utilized in meeting these requirements, and

WHEREAS, the deadline for this application is October 20, 2006, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to submit an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), for Round 9 Water Quality Improvement Projects in an amount not to exceed \$105,000.00, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and
