Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into An Agreement With The New York National Guard's Counter Drug Procurement Program To Allow For The Purchase Of The Communications And Command Vehicle Directly Through Government Contract

The Criminal Justice / Public Safety / STOP DWI Committee (Chairman Meyer and Legislators Aiello, DePew, Every, Dart, Feldmann and Hyatt) offers the following:

WHEREAS, Ulster County has previously approved a homeland security grant for the purchase of an Ulster County multi-jurisdictional communications and command vehicle, and

WHEREAS, the communications and command vehicle is available for purchase directly from a Government contract through the Law Enforcement Assistance Program, known as "The 1122 Program", which results in a quality product with significant cost savings, and

WHEREAS, "The 1122 Program" is administered at the direction of Governor Pataki by the New York National Guard's Counter Drug Procurement Program and a contractual agreement is required between the County and the New York Counter Drug Procurement Program (NYCDPP) to facilitate this purchase, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice/Public Safety/STOP DWI Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York National Guard's Counter Drug Procurement Program to allow for the purchase of the communications and command vehicle directly through Government contract,

and moves its adoption.
