

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Contract With The New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services For The Ignition Interlock Device Monitoring Program – Department Of Probation, STOP - DWI

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Richard Parete, and Deputy Chairman Kenneth Ronk offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of Ulster County Probation – Division of STOP- DWI; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Probation has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (NYS Comptroller's No. C523700), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the period October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013 in the amount of \$55,215.00; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used for the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee (GTSC) Ignition Interlock Device Monitoring Program (the "Program") to offset the cost of administering the Program by the Ulster County Probation Department which promotes and increases community safety; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute a contract (NYS Comptroller's No. C523700), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the GTSC Ignition Interlock Device Monitoring Program for the period October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013 in the amount of \$55,215.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, Counsel to the County Legislature, Chairman of the County Legislature, and the Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee; and, be it further

RESOLVED, if State funding for this program is eliminated, the County's participation will be reviewed by the Ways and Means Committee,

and moves its adoption.
