WHEREAS, this Program provides funding for processing (1) initial day-care facility registration applications, (2) renewals of existing registrations, (3) complaint investigations, and (4) safety assessments, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding and any amendments thereto with the New York State OCFS to receive funding in the amount of \$139,787.00 for the Day Care Registration and Inspection Program, for the term beginning January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
