WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Tourism, and

WHEREAS, the Hudson River Valley Greenway Act (the “Greenway Act”), Chapter 748 of the Laws of 1991, has as a primary function to establish a Hudson River Valley Greenway Trail system that links cultural and historic sites, parks, open spaces and community centers, and provides public access to the Hudson River, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature endorsed the designation of Ulster County as a Greenway Community and membership in the Hudson Valley Greenway by adoption of Resolution No. 133, dated April 11, 2002, and

WHEREAS, grant funds are available for promoting trails and parks in Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services and Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development and Tourism Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature supports the submittal of an application to the Hudson River Valley Greenway Water Trail Grant program in the amount of \$5,000.00 for development and production of a parks and trails map for Ulster County,
