WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Finance has requested permission to accept a bid for a parcel of County-owned property as hereinafter described, acquired by the County by reason of non-payment of taxes, and having been offered at Public Auction, and

WHEREAS, Parcel # 5 of the 2008 Public Auction, listed as 2.3 acres, landlocked, in the Town of Gardiner, section block and lot number 92.4-1-57.200, has unpaid taxes in the amount of \$3,198.29 dating back to the year 2005 up to and including the 2009 general property tax, and

WHEREAS, the prospective purchaser of Parcel # 5 has bid \$2635.00 for the property which falls within the price range determined upon review by the Real Property Tax Service Agency, and

WHEREAS, the prospective purchaser shall be responsible for the 2009-10 school tax and all subsequent tax levies, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is hereby authorized to accept a bid of \$2,635.00 for the property known as Parcel # 5 of the 2008 Public Auction, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the sale of this property is contingent upon payment in the amount of \$2,635.00 by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation to the Ulster County Commissioner of Finance:
