WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-44(A) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A6-1(A) of the Administrative Code: "There shall be a Department of Mental Health, headed by a Commissioner of Mental Health. The Commissioner of Mental Health shall be experienced in public mental health administration and meet the qualifications for this position as specified in the New York State Mental Hygiene Law and/or by the State Commissioner of Mental Hygiene. He or she shall be appointed by the County Executive in consultation with the Community Services Board and with confirmation by the County Legislature and serve at his or her pleasure," and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has appointed LaMar Hasbrouck, MD, MPH, as Commissioner of Mental Health, pending confirmation of the New York State Department of Mental Hygiene Inter-Office Coordinating Council (IOCC); this appointment shall begin on April 1, 2011, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hasbrouck's appointment as Commissioner of Mental Health is in addition to this appointment as the Director of Public Health, and

WHEREAS, the Health Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature confirms the appointment of LaMar Hasbrouck, MD, MPH, Commissioner of Mental Health, pending confirmation of the New York State Department of Mental Hygiene Inter-Office Coordinating Council (IOCC); this appointment shall begin on April 1, 2011,
