WHEREAS, the mission of the Early Intervention Program is to identify and evaluate as early as possible those infants and toddlers whose health and development are compromised and provide appropriate intervention to improve child and family development, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed this request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed this request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Department of Health (Contract No. C-025251) and any amendments thereto, to receive additional funding for the Early Intervention Program from ARRA, for the term of October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2011, in the amount of \$69,463.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and, be it further
