# Resolution No. 7 January 4, 2011

Establishing Capital Project No. 336 For The Repaying Of South Putt Corners Road In The Town Of New Paltz – Transportation Improvement Project (TIP) Not On The State Highway System – Department Of Public Works (Highways And Bridges)

The Budget and Finance Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Bernardo, Frey, Hansut, Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Lomita, Provenzano and Sheeley) and Co-Sponsor: Legislator Rodriguez offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works (Highway and Bridges), and

WHEREAS, the South Putt Corners Road Paving Project, PIN 8759.90 (the "Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, which calls for the Project costs to be paid with 80% federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and

WHEREAS, the Project is eligible for New York State Marchiselli Aid, and if this aid becomes available, then Ulster County's financial obligation to the Project will be diminished from its present 20% share to a 5% share, and

WHEREAS, the Project was approved by the Ulster County Transportation Council in the 2008 – 2012 Transportation Improvement Program, and

WHEREAS, the Project was designated as part of the 2011–2016 Ulster County Capital Program, pursuant to Resolution No. 299, dated December 6, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Project will provide major improvements to existing road conditions and enhance both driving safety and the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works requests funds for the preliminary engineering and right-of-way incidentals for the Project in the amount of \$178,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Project constitutes a Type II action under section 2.25 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List that was adopted in Resolution No. 118 on April 20, 2010, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County determines that this action does not pose a significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and

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WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Capital Project No. 336 be established for the South Putt Corners Road Paving Project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves the Project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County 2011-2016 Capital Program be amended to increase the Project from \$175,000.00 to \$178,000.00, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the 2011 Ulster County Capital Fund Budget is hereby amended as follows:
