WHEREAS, these funds will be used for the New York's Rockefeller Drug Law Reform (RDLR) Program to provide Probation supervision services for drugdependent individuals pursuant to said program (RDLR) while ensuring that their treatment and service needs are met in order to reduce offender recidivism and promote community safety, and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
