## Resolution No. 76 March 16, 2010

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement For The Maintenance Of Facilities For The Ulster Performing Arts Center For The 2010 Appropriation – Legislature

The Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee (Chairman Harris and Legislators Belfiglio, Hayes, Terrizzi, Donaldson, Gregorius and Madsen) offers the following:

WHEREAS, performing arts are an important component of our cultural heritage, and the many performances arranged by the Ulster Performing Arts Center attract the Hudson Valley County residents as well as travelers to see a broad range of entertainment for the community, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 361 dated December 16, 2009, the Ulster County Legislature authorized the Commissioner of Finance to transfer the allocation in the amount of \$18,750.00 to the 2010 Ulster County Budget for the Ulster Performing Arts Center 2010 Appropriation, for the maintenance of facilities, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Law Section 224 (13), in order to receive such funds, the Ulster Performing Arts Center must submit to the Ulster County Legislature a verified accounting of disbursements to be undertaken, and to the Commissioner of Finance, a Memorandum of Receipt signed by the principal officer, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster Performing Arts Center will receive payment in the amount of \$18,750.00, in accordance with the terms specified in an agreement with the County of Ulster and the Ulster Performing Arts Center and will return any unexpended funds as of December 31, 2010, along with a certified accounting of expenditures to the Commissioner of Finance, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller and/or any and all officers of the County of Ulster, their agents and representatives, shall be allowed full access upon reasonable notice and at reasonable times to the books, papers, records and premises of the Ulster Performing Arts Center, during the period that this resolution is in effect for

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the purpose of ascertaining the manner in which the above sum of money is being used or applied, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the above organization agrees to comply with all applicable Federal, State and local regulations including, in particular, any forbidding discrimination by such organization, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement in the amount of \$18,750.00 for the maintenance of facilities for the Ulster Performing Arts Center, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
