WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 149 dated May 18, 2010, the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature executed an agreement with the New York State Homeland Security Agency for the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Contract (Contract No. C835392) in the amount of \$138,500.00, for the period beginning August 1, 2009 and ending July 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, this contract is a federally funded program (CFDA # 97.067) administered by the New York State Homeland Security Agency and which requires no matching County funds, and

WHEREAS, the goal of the State Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program is to prevent, prepare for and recover from terrorist attacks, and

WHEREAS, during the years 2010 and 2011, the Sheriff's Office spent \$72,973.00 of the \$138,500.00 leaving an unexpended balance of \$65,707.00, and

WHEREAS, the unexpended balance will be used to purchase and place in service a mobile computing system to establish and enhance terrorism intelligence and early warning systems, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requests that the unexpended funds be appropriated and that the 2012 Ulster County Budget be amended accordingly, now, therefore, be it
