WHEREAS, the Ulster County District Attorney has been awarded funding in the amount of \$99,500.00 by the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) for participation in the Crimes Against Revenue Program (CARP) for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used exclusively to hire a designated Assistant District Attorney to specialize in the investigation and prosecution of revenue crimes against New York State committed within Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney requests that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement (NYS Contract No. 108371) with the New York State DCJS for participation in CARP for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012 in the amount of \$99,500.00, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (NYS Contract No. 108371), in the amount of \$99,500.00 for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,

and moves its adoption.
