

**Authorizing A Memorandum Of Agreement By And Between The CSEA And The Ulster County Department Of Buildings And Grounds For The “On-Duty” Pager Policy To Remain In Effect Until The New Ulster County Law Enforcement Center Opens**

The Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee (Chairman Felicello and Legislators Hathaway, McAfee, Meyer, Stock, Berardi, Donaldson, Provenzano and Zimet) offers the following:

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement between the Ulster County Department of Buildings and Grounds and the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc., Local 1000, AFSCME, AFL-CIO for the Ulster Unit, Ulster County Local 856 was entered into this the 27<sup>th</sup> day of December 2004, and

WHEREAS, the “on-duty” pager policy which is to remain in effect until the new Ulster County Law Enforcement Center opens, is subject to the approval by the Ulster County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee has met and reviewed said memorandum with a majority of members voting approval, and

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature authorizes the Memorandum of Agreement between the Ulster County Department of Buildings and Grounds and the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc., Local 1000, AFSCME, AFL-CIO for the Ulster Unit, Ulster County Local 856 above referred to as on file with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature,

and moves its adoption.
