The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairman Hayes and Legislators Belfiglio, Ronk, Sweeney, Briggs, Hochberg and Rodriguez) and Co-Sponsors: The Health and Human Services Committee (Chairman Frey, Harris, Maio, Ronk, Petit, Briggs, Loughran, Robert Parete, and Stoeckeler) offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution was submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County District Attorney, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney requests that the 2011 Ulster County Budget be amended to fund a Memorandum of Agreement to provide for investigative services for the Department of Social Services Food Stamp Program, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney will provide the services of a part time investigator who shall investigate and prosecute persons suspected of Food Stamp fraud and abuse, as determined by guidelines and statutes provided by State and Federal Agencies, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney will be reimbursed on a monthly basis at the rate of \$27.47 per hour from the Department of Social Services for such services, not to exceed the amount of \$25,959.15, and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and approved said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
