WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Health, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-026543) and any amendments to the contract, with the New York State Department of Health Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, for the period October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015, and

WHEREAS, funding will be used to support and enhance local efforts to reduce the prevalence of elevated blood lead levels in children through the implementation of a comprehensive lead poisoning prevention program which includes: public and professional outreach and education; collaboration with local health care providers for screening/testing, diagnostic evaluation, medical management, education and environmental interventions.

WHEREAS, the Health Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-026543) and any amendments to the contract, with the New York State Department of Health Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, for the period October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015, and accept first year funding in the amount of \$42,718.00 (10/1/10-9/30/11), in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
