

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The New York State Office Of Children And Family Services To Accept A Grant For The Child And Family Safety Program – Department Of Social Services

The Health and Human Services Committee (Chairman Frey and Legislators Harris, Maio, Petit, Ronk, Briggs, Loughran, Robert Parete and Stoeckeler) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Social Services, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement with the New York State Office of Children and Family Services to accept a grant for the Child and Family Safety Program for the period beginning February 1, 2011, and ending January 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to continue and enhance the Multidisciplinary Team (MDT), and

WHEREAS, the grant will improve coordination among law enforcement, child protective services, health care and other community agencies involved in child abuse investigations, and those protecting abused and neglected children, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the New York State Office of Children and Family Services, and any amendments thereto, to accept a grant for the Child and Family Safety Program for the period beginning February 1, 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
