A Local Law Amending Local Law Number 1 Of 1989 Adopting The Code Of Ethics, And Requiring Certain County Officers And Local Political Parties To File A Financial Disclosure Form Pursuant To The General Municipal Law And Local Law Number 1 Of 1990 Amending Local Law Number 1 Of 1989 To Provide A Maximum Dollar Amount On The Receipt Of Gifts, To Establish A Fixed Term For Board Of Ethics Members, To Authorize The Board Of Ethics To Enforce The Financial Disclosure Filing Requirement, And To Delete Certain Titles From The Requirement Of Disclosure

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Ulster as follows:

SECTION 4. Section 4 of Local Law Number 1 of 1990 amending Local Law Number 1 of 1989 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. CERTAIN POLITICAL OFFICES PROHIBITED

No elected County official, nor any County Department Head, nor any County Commissioner or Chairperson of any County Committee, Commission or Board shall hold the office of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer or any other executive office in any County political party or political committee.

The foregoing shall not preclude any candidate for elected office from holding any office within his or her own political campaign committee even if that campaign committee provides for one or more candidates."

SECTION 5. Section 5 of Local Law Number 1 of 1990 as amended by Local Law Number 1 of 1989 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE This local law shall take effect immediately."
