2022 External Audit of the Annual Financial Statements

Chair Bartels introduced Melissa Szot and Christopher Kopf from PFK O'Connor Davies. Ms. Szot informed the Committee of the external audit's status, timeline, and open testing procedures. Ms. Szot also explained that a reconciliation has not been completed for receivables in the Department of Social Services, stating that a write off is anticipated but the exact value will not be known until the reconciliation is completed by the Department and tested by the firm. Mr. Kopf explained the reconciliation process for the account in discussion. Further discussion pursued on open testing items, including the accounting for leases as they relate to compliance with GASB 87. Ms. Szot continued stating that the firm is assisting in the preparation of the financial statements this year but that not all supplemental schedules are financial statement related, so without participation by the County additional schedules may need to be omitted.

Chair Bartels emphasized the importance of knowing the ending fund balance value as the Legislature enters the budget cycle. Ms. Szot informed the Committee that missing the financial statement deadline has audit repercussions for the subsequent period, acknowledging that the timeline is tight and assuring the Committee that the firm is working hard to meet the deadline. Mr. Kopf confirmed that the Legislature will be provided an ending fund balance value before the budget cycle begins, even if the financial statements are not yet completed in full. Further discussion took place on the potential effects of the Tyler v. Hennepin Supreme Court Ruling. Ms. Szot and Mr. Kopf answered Committee member questions.

Motion No. 2: To approve a one-year extension on the current contract with PFK O'Connor Davies for external audit services for the 2023 fiscal year end.
