WHEREAS, the goal of the NY Connects Program is to provide information and assistance to older adults and individuals of any age with disabilities about long-term services and supports throughout the county, including rural areas and underserved populations; and

WHEREAS, the term for the NY Connects program is April 1, 2025, through March 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, if the County's application is approved, the funds will be used to reimburse the County for NY Connects expenditures incurred by the Ulster County Office for the Aging, including salaries, benefits, operational costs, technology and marketing costs; and

WHEREAS, reimbursement for County expenditures will be available after submission by the County and approval by the New York State Office for the Aging of an application, standard assurances, program narratives and program budget; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office for the Aging requests the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute the NY Connects Program Application, with required assurances, and any amendments thereto; now, therefore, be it
