Chairman of the Health, Human Services and Human Rights Committee, Abe Uchitelle, and Deputy Chair Craig V. Lopez offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of Ulster County Veterans Services Agency; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation has issued a call for applications under the Section 5310 Program – Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Veterans Services intends to apply for Section 5310 funds for vehicle replacement to continue providing mobility services for seniors and individuals with disabilities, consistent with the Ulster County Transportation Council's adopted Human Services Coordinated Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, a local match of twenty percent (20%) for capital projects and fifty percent (50%) for operating support is required; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby authorizes the submission of an application by Ulster County Veterans Services Agency to the New York State Department of Transportation for Section 5310 Program funding; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any required applications or agreements, and any amendments thereto, to secure such funding,

and moves its adoption.
