WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Personnel; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section A3-4(J) of the Ulster County Administrative Code, the County Executive has negotiated a collective bargaining agreement between the County and the Ulster County Civil Service Employees Association Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the agreement is for the period January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the contract results in the following:

• 7- Hour and DSS Salary Schedule:

Effective December 31, 2025 at 11:59 PM: Grades 1-16, 3.0% increase to the entry rate. Steps 1-6 increased by \$2.00. Grades 17 and above, entry rate increase by 3%. Steps 1-6 increase by 5.5%;

Effective January 1, 2026: Grades 1-16, 3.0% increase to the entry step. Steps 1-6 increased by \$2.00. Grades 17 and above, entry rate increase by 3%. Steps 1-6 increase by 5.0%;

Effective January 1, 2027: Grades 1-16, 3.0% increase to the entry rate. Steps 1-6 increased by \$2.00. Grades 17 and above, entry rate increase by 3%. Steps 1-6 increase by 4.0%;

Effective January 1. 2028: Grades 1-16, 3.0% increase to the entry rate. Steps 1-6 increased by \$2.00. Grades 17 and above 3% to the entry rate. Steps 1-6 increase by 4.0%;

• <u>DPW Salary Schedule</u>:

Effective December 31, 2025 at 11:59 PM: All grades, 3% increase to the entry rate. Steps 1-6 increased by \$2.00;

Effective January 1, 2026: All grades, 3% increase to the entry rate. Steps 1-6, increased by 3.5%;

Effective December 31, 2025 at 11:59 PM: All grades 3% increase to the entry rate. Steps 1-6 increased by 3.5%;

2026, 2027, 2028: 3.0% increase to the entry level through step 6; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement further makes adjustments to callin pay, uniform allowance, meal allowance, bereavement leave and contains a new take-home vehicle use policy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section A2-5(9) of the Ulster County Administrative Code, all labor contracts must be approved by the County Legislature; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves the Memorandum of Agreement covering the period January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2028, between the County of Ulster and the Ulster County Civil Service Employees Association Inc.; and, be it further
