RESOLVED, the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute the amendment to the Agreement with the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services, for the period beginning April 1, 2024 and ending March 31, 2027, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
