

Establishing Capital Project No. 746 For UCAT Bus Shelters Purchase 2026 – Amending The 2026 Capital Fund Budget – Ulster County Area Transit (UCAT)

Chairman of the Housing and Transportation Committee, Jeff Collins, Deputy Chair Thomas Corcoran, and Legislators Clinton, Hewitt, McCollough and Stewart offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of Ulster County Area Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the 2026 - 2031 Capital Improvement Program includes \$500,000.00 for bus shelter purchases; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been allocated by the Ulster County Transportation Council from Unallocated FTA/Section 5307/5340 Formula Funds from the Mid-Hudson Valley Transportation Management Area; and

WHEREAS, this project includes the purchase of bus shelters to be installed at bus stops within the UCAT Service area; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Transportation requests Capital Project No. 746 be established and funded in the amount of \$500,000.00 for the purchase of bus shelters; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, based upon examination by the Ulster County Legislature, the County's funding of this Project constitutes a Type II action as defined under Sections 4.7.4 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List, which was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 118 dated April 20, 2010; and, be it further

RESOLVED, Ulster County has determined that this funding action does not pose a significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and does not require any further determination or procedure under SEQRA; and, be it further
