

Authorizing The Chair Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With Ulster County Board Of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) To Provide One (1) Additional Deputy Sheriff As School Resource Officer – Ulster County Sheriff

Chair of the Legislature, Peter J. Criswell, offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the Ulster County Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County BOCES has requested one (1) additional full time Deputy Sheriff trained as a School Resource Officer (SRO) to be assigned to a location requested by BOCES; and

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster, through its Sheriff's Office will be reimbursed by Ulster County BOCES in the amount of \$46,857.50 for the services of the additional Deputy Sheriff assigned as the School Resource Officer; and

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with Ulster County BOCES to provide a Deputy Sheriff to serve as a School Resource Officer for the term January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
