Chairwoman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Debra Clinton, and Deputy Chair Richard Walls offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County operates a single County Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) responsible for receiving and dispatching emergency 911 calls for the residents and visitors of Ulster County; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Interoperability Emergency Communications has established grant programs to support the planning, development, and implementation of Next Generation 911 (NG911) systems across the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, NG911 represents a modern, IP-based emergency communications system that enhances resiliency, interoperability, cybersecurity, data sharing, and the ability to receive voice, text, images, video, and other digital data from the public; and

WHEREAS, the New York State SFY2025 Next Generation 911 (NG911) Grant Program is intended to assist counties in upgrading and modernizing 911 emergency communications systems by funding the acquisition and implementation of NG911-compliant call handling equipment, software, and related technologies, thereby supporting the transition from legacy 911 systems to an Internet Protocol-based NG911 environment that enhances interoperability, resiliency, and the ability to receive voice, text, and data from the public during emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Emergency Services has received notification from the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the New York State SFY2025 Next Generation 911 (NG911) Grant Program; now, therefore be it
