WHEREAS, in order to use remaining unspent Opioid Settlement funds from 2025 to implement mental health programs throughout Ulster County in 2026, it is necessary to amend the 2026 Ulster County Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, there is no increase in County contribution as a result of these modifications; now, therefore, be it further
