Chair of the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, Kathy Nolan, and Deputy Chair Jason Kovacs offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, a capital project titled, “Fire Alarm and Access Control Upgrade Program” was approved in the 2026 – 2031 Capital Improvement Program in the amount of \$550,000.00 for fiscal year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the safety and security of all residents and employees occupying County buildings is of paramount importance; and

WHEREAS, existing fire alarm and security systems in County-owned facilities require significant upgrades; and

WHEREAS, proactive investment in modern fire prevention and security measures will enhance public safety, reduce injury and prevent injury, and protect valuable public assets; and

WHEREAS, a project goal is to install passive and active security measures at County Offices to increase the safety of the staff and the public; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to upgrade the fire alarm system and add enhanced security measures and camera systems to restrict unauthorized access to sensitive locations in those County facilities; and

WHEREAS, this project will use passive and active security measures at the Hall of Records on Foxhall Avenue, SUNY Kingston on Mary’s Avenue, the Probation Building on 733 Broadway, and the Emergency Management Building on Golden Hill Drive, and various other County-owned buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works requests that Capital Project No. 754 be established and funded; now, therefore, be it
