

Authorizing The Chair Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into A Funding Agreement Under The 2025 Election Grant Program With The NYS Board Of Elections – Ulster County Board Of Elections

Chairman of the Laws, Rules and Government Services Committee, Aaron Levine, and Deputy Chair Jason Kovacs offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Board of Elections; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Board of Elections received a 2025 General Election Grant in the amount of \$12,170.00 to cover the unbudgeted expenses incurred during the administration of 2025 Elections; and

WHEREAS, The New York State Board of Elections will administer this grant and the term of this grant program will be 04/01/2025 to 03/31/2026; and

WHEREAS, in 2025 the Ulster County Board of Elections will conduct local year elections and will expend funds to administrate the election in some areas not previously budgeted for; and

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign a grant agreement in the amount of \$12,170.00 with the NYS Board of Elections to obtain 2025 General Election Grant Program funds to offset eligible expenses, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
